Sir/Madam,

On behalf of the Director-General, I am delighted to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Korea, represented by the Korean International Cooperation Agency (KOICA), is offering twenty-five (25) fellowships of two months' duration for the benefit of least developed countries (LDCs) in Africa and Asia and the Pacific, within the framework of the UNESCO/KOICA Joint Fellowship Programme – 2016.

Aimed at enhancing national capacity building, these fellowships will enable candidates to participate in a training course in the field of education. The training will be held from **1 September to 31 October 2016** at the Asia-Pacific Centre of Education for International Understanding (APCEIU) in Seoul, Republic of Korea. The medium of instruction being English, only candidates proficient in this language are eligible to apply.

The annexes to this letter provide detailed information concerning the qualifications required, the facilities offered, the general conditions governing the award of fellowships and the procedures for the submission of applications.

The final selection lies with KOICA and APCEIU.
